I am a researcher and professor at the Department of Linguistics and Basque Studies in the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU) since 2004 (Associate professor since 1989). I am the I.P. of the research group *Basque and Beyond* financially supported by the CNU in previous calls (CNU 2008, 2011, 2014, 2018). I obtained my PhD in 1997 with a dissertation entitled *Egiturazko kasuaren erkaketa euskaraz* [Structural case checking in Basque] at the UPV/EHU. I am a Corresponding Member of *Euskaltzaindia*, the Royal Academy of the Basque Language since 2013. During my academic career, I have been involved in the study of linguistic variation, focusing especially on Basque morphosyntactic variation. I have edited collective volumes of scientific papers in some of the world's most prestigious publishing companies (Elsevier, OUP, John Benjamins, Brill). I am committed to enhance language awareness beyond scientific spheres. Regarding this, I have recently published two books (2016, 2017) and collaborated every fortnight with *Euskadi Irratia* –the Basque public radio– in the program *Faktoria Magazina*, (2017-18) in a section dedicated to language.
