Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)

I am a Full Professor in the Department of English, German and Translation and Interpretation Studies of the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU). I have taught undergraduate courses at the



University of Iowa (USA) and the UPV/EHU and graduate courses/seminars at the UPV/EHU, UNED, the Cervantes Institute and several national and international universities. I have supervised 15 Ph.D. theses and 10 more are in progress. I have been the recipient of excellence awards for teaching at The University of Iowa and the UPV/EHU.

My research has focused on the acquisition of the morphosyntax of English as an L2/L3 (generative perspective) and the analysis of oral interaction among learners of English as a foreign language (EFL) (cognitive-psycholinguistic and sociocultural perspectives). I have participated in 23 competitive research projects and I have been Principal Investigator (PI) in nine of them. Since 2007 I have been the PI of the Consolidated Research Group Language and Speech (www.laslab.org), highlighted by the Basque Government for Excellence in research. I have also been an external expert in several international research projects and research centers, an assessor of ANEP (Spanish Evaluation and Foresight Agency) and ANECA (Spanish National Agency of Quality Evaluation and Accreditation), the coordinator of international mobility grants in the areas of Philology and Philosophy (2016-2018) - ANECA- and a reviewer of research proposals for various autonomous and international agencies. I was one of the five experts selected to discuss the National Plan for the reform of the teaching of foreign languages (Ministry of Education, 2009-2010). From June 2016 to July 2019 I was the coordinator of the Modern Languages section and the Language and Linguistics section in the Spanish National Research Agency. Since June 2021 I am a member of the Spanish State Research Agency Board (Vocal del Consejo Rector de la Agencia Estatal de Investigación (AEI)- Spanish State Research Agency.

I have been awarded the AESLA research prize for senior researchers. I have edited numerous volumes in international prestigious publishers (De Gruyter, John Benjamins, Multilingual Matters) and have also been an invited editor of four special issues (Bilingualism: Language and Cognition: International Journal of Educational Research, International Review of Applied Linguistics, System). I have published numerous articles in prestigious journals (Applied Linguistics; Bilingualism: Language and Cognition; International Journal of Educational Research, International Review of Applied Linguistics, Language Awareness, Language Learning, Language Teaching Research, Linguistic Approaches to Bilingualism; Second Language Research, System) and chapters in highly ranked publishing companies (Cambridge University Press, John Benjamins, Mouton de Gruyter, Multilingual Matters, Springer). I am the editor of Language Teaching Research (Sage, Q1), member of the editorial board of various international journals and book series and reviewer for most impact journals and publishers in my research area. I have been an external reviewer in Ph.D. committees in Europe and Australia and have evaluated promotion applications in European and North American universities. I have been a plenary speaker in China, Greece, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, the UK, the USA and many Spanish universities. I have also been heavily involved in administrative work as I was responsible for several Ph.D. programs (1998-2013) at the UPV/EHU, the MA program in Language Acquisition in Multilingual Settings (since it started in 2009) and I have been the Head of my Department since 2016.
