Juan Antonio Quirós Castillo, Professor of Medieval Archaeology at the University of the Basque Country, Honorary Senior Research Associate at the Institute of Archaeology (University College London), and former Visiting Fellow at All Souls College (University of Oxford, 2018).

I am director of the "Heritage and Cultural Landscapes Research Group" of the University of the Basque Country from 2007 (25 researchers in different fields) and the Associate Unit "Rural Medieval Research Group" CSIC-UPV/EHU from 2016.

I have been in charge of five research projects in the framework of the Spanish National R&D&I Plan, four European Research projects and a number of national and regional funded actions awarded on a competitive basis. Besides this, I have been Principal Investigator of ca 50 research contracts with public institutions. Moreover, I have directed archaeological projects and excavations in Italy, France and Spain (Asturias, Basque Country and Castile and Leon). I have been visiting professor in the universities of Lisbon, Bologna, Siena, Padua, Florence, Verona and London.

In the last ten years I have published 15 books, 60 chapter books, 42 papers in indexed journals and a number of other publications. Furthermore, I have given 41 keynotes and papers in workshops, conferences and congresses, as well as 32 communications. Besides this, I have organized regularly from 2008 the series of seminars "Conferences on Medieval Archaeology in Northern Iberia" (13 editions).

I have a large experience evaluating research projects applications and contracts for European (European Union, Island, Poland, Italy, Czech Republic) and National agencies. I have reviewed papers for more than 25 international and national journals, and 5 series editors. My principal interests lie in the archaeology study of landscapes, the archaeology of local societies, Mediterranean Archaeology, Archaeology of Architectures, and the study of Social Complexity. Besides, I am very interested in a multi-proxy and multidisciplinary approach to cultural resources.

In the last few years, I have promoted a line of research entitled "archaeology of peasantries" focused on subalterns and producers in historical societies, focused on the study of



settlements, agrarian landscapes, the agrarian chaîne opératoire, and the bioarchaeology and geoarchaeology records. I am currently writing a book about these topics.
